

2024-25 Dress Code: Preschool-Grade 5

Students in our Early Childhood Division sections of preschool 3s and 4s are required to follow a modified dress code, with a crew neck shirt in red, white or navy, collar not required. Children should be dressed comfortably and in clothing that makes it easy for them to use the bathroom independently.

Students in Kindergarten are required to be in full dress code daily. Items where the crest is **not** required can be purchased from any vendor.

Standard Uniform Requirements for Kindergarten-Grade 5

- All uniforms are gender-neutral
- White, red, or navy short/long-sleeve polo with crest (one short-sleeved polo in each color provided for each 2024-25 family as a part of tuition)
- · Red or navy sweater, sweatshirt, jacket, or hoodie with crest
- · Navy or khaki pants, pinafores, or skirts
- Navy leggings or tumble shorts for wearing under skirts
- Sneakers with no distractions (wheels, lights, etc.)

Formal Dress Code

- On formal dress code days, students may wear any of the following: a collared shirt, khaki or navy pants or skirt, and a school sweater or blazer
- Formal dress code days might include: Photo Day, special field trips, music concerts, etc.

Physical Education

- Red or navy short/long-sleeve t-shirt (One navy PE shirt provided for each 2024-25 family as a part of tuition)
- Navy joggers, mesh shorts, or leggings (One navy PE short provided for each 2024-25 family as a part of tuition)
- Sneakers with no distractions (wheels, lights, etc.)
- Swimsuits, swim caps and goggles for grades K-5

Water Bottles

All students in grades K-5 are required to keep a reusable water bottle at School.

Backpacks

Dwight School backpacks will be available for purchase from the Lion Shop after the start of school.
